

2027 Moda PEBB Plans Overview

Effective Jan. 1, 2027

Medical

- Moda will be offering two plans, Moda Coordinated Care and Moda PPO.
 - Both plans use Moda's large Connexus network available in Oregon, SW Washington, Idaho, and Alaska.
 - For care outside of the Connexus service area, members can utilize the Aetna PPO® Network through Aetna Signature Administrators®.
- **Moda Coordinated Care plan:**
 - The Coordinated Care plan is available to members who live in Oregon and surrounding counties.
 - Subscribers who have a dependent child who lives outside the Connexus service area can still enroll in the Coordinated Care plan.
 - **PCP 360:** Members on the Coordinated Care plan must select and see a PCP 360 clinic for primary care services to receive in-network benefits for that office visit.
 - A PCP 360 is a primary care clinic/facility that has been certified by the Oregon Patient-Centered Primary Care Program or other similar programs.
 - Providence primary care providers will be PCP 360s starting with the 2027 plan year.
- **Moda PPO**
 - The PPO plan is available nationwide. Members can select this plan if they live in Oregon or throughout the country.

- **Garner:**
 - Garner is a benefit that helps you find high-quality doctors and get reimbursed for eligible out-of-pocket medical costs. When you visit a Garner Top Provider, not only is your office visit eligible for reimbursement, Garner will also reimburse any labs, imaging and prescription associated with that visit up to:
 - Moda's Coordinated Care plan \$1,250 for an individual and \$2,500 for a family
 - Moda's PPO plan \$1,000 for an individual and \$2,000 for a family.

Dental

- The full-time Delta Dental PPO and Premier plans have a \$1,750 annual benefit maximum and a \$50 deductible.
- The PPO plan offers an incentive-style benefit for Basic Services like fillings, meaning that each year you see your Delta Dental PPO provider, your incentive level will increase by ten percent for those services.
- PEBB dental members have the Preventive First benefit. This means all preventive services do not accrue toward the annual benefit maximum, giving members additional dollars to use for basic and major services, such as fillings, crowns, and implant.
